Candidates can download the Hall Tickets from the link given on <http://aptet.cgg.gov.in> from afternoon on 24.11.2011 by entering their Reference ID. Hall Tickets will not be issued in any other form other than online download from <http://aptet.cgg.gov.in>.
3. Photographs of certain candidates are rejected due to unclear or smaller size image or no signature. All such candidates are informed about the rejected photograph through repeated SMS over their Mobile Phone since 10.12.2011 and a Press notification on 18.12.2011. These candidates were given opportunity to reload their photographs from the link given on <http://aptet.cgg.gov.in> upto 5.00 PM on 21.12.2011. Hall Tickets are not generated for those candidates who did not reload their photographs along with signature till 21.12.2011. These candidates may approach APTET office situated at O/o the Commissioner and Director of School Education, Hyderabad between 02.01.2012 and 07.01.2012 during the office hours i.e. 10.30 AM to 5.00 PM personally with three Passport size photographs and related documents in proof of their identity for issue of Hall Ticket.
4. Certain other candidates have submitted more than one application. The latest application is accepted and the earlier applications are rejected. Hall Tickets are not generated for earlier submitted applications. Objections of the candidates if any in this regard may be brought to the notice of the Director, APTET personally between 02.01.2012 to 07.01.2012 during working hours.
