- iv. If candidate submits 'Physical Copy' of the demat memo, the 'USER' (Recruiting Agency) may verify the contents by logging into the website <https://www.nad.co.in> duly obtaining USER ID from the C&DSE-A.P. and Ex-Officio Director, APTET, Hyderabad.
